Statement on Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA)

The Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) was amended by the Frank R. Lautenberg Chemical Safety for the 21st Century Act, by issuing five chemicals to reduce exposures to certain chemicals that are persistent, bioaccumulative and toxic (PBT).

Nexperia B.V. hereby declares that these five PBT chemicals mentioned in this TSCA amendment are not contained within its products. The five PBT chemicals are:
